Topic of the Month

What's in a name?

This month, Dr. John McCormack joined our practice. You may notice that his veterinary degree is noted as MVB, while Dr. Croushore and Dr. Pickett have DVM degrees, and Dr. Welch and Dr. Zawisza have VMD degrees. Perhaps you are wondering what that means.

There are a number of veterinary degree options available. In addition to DVM, VMD, and MVB, there are BVM, BVMS, BVSc, DMV, and numerous others. Mostly, the degree given has to do with the school it was received from or the country where it was awarded. DVM stands for Doctor of Veterinary Medicine and is what most of the schools in the US offer. VMD means the same thing but in Latin, which is how that school chooses to confer its degree. MVB is for Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine. The programs may be structured a little bit differently but there is also some oversight to ensure consistency.

In order to practice in the US, a degree must be earned at a school recognized by the American Veterinary Medical Association or the veterinarian must pass rigorous testing to demonstrate proficiency in veterinary practice. After that, veterinarians must be licensed by the state board in any state where they wish to practice. So the particular set of letters behind a veterinarian's name mostly just give a little hint about where they went to school.
